

Who I am in Christ Jesus

Many Christians struggle with successful living in most areas because of their lack of understanding of who they are in fullness of the promises of God. This study has been compiled to help people find their identity in Christ and over the years has been applied effectively as a counselling tool for many individuals that are faced with identity crisis difficulties. The course that we are about to describe has been used with great results.

In this booklet is a list of seventy-two principles that will instruct you the believer in the ways of the Lord, and prayerfully will enable you to walk in the power of his might and give you the strength to overcome the enemy.

Step 1.

Take the first scripture on page one on the first day. Look it up in your Bible and speak it out aloud. Write it out on a piece of paper or card.

Step 2.

Meditate on it (think over and over) all day. This will allow the content of that truth from the Word of God to get deep into your Spirit.

Step 3.

At the end of the day make sure you speak it out again, then thank the Lord for receiving the word as revelation and for the effect it will have in your life in the days, weeks and months to come.

Step 4.

In your own words, write down on paper what the scripture now means to you, and how you think that it will effect you in the days to come.

Step 5.

Repeat the above process each day with the next scripture.

Step 6.

At the finish of the week we advise you to then write out an overall summary of how you are feeling in the light of your study, and take all of you notes to your counsellor. The counsellor will then discuss your improvement and ask you to continue the program until such a time that you are walking king in victory.

NOTE: The summary statement before each verse can be used as a positive faith confession during the day and then in the weeks and months to come, continue to speak them out a 'vision' you have discovered.

Meditating in God's Word

When God speaks of success, He relates it to the activity of meditation in His Word.



Joshua 1:8 "This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth; but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success "

Psalm 1: 2-3 "But his delight is in the law of the Lord, and in His law he meditates day and night He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season. Whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper ".

To meditate literally means to repeat over and over in the mind, what which we have memorised. By doing this with God's Word we reprogram our actions and thoughts so that they become new.

Meditation involves basically three steps:

	1. Memorise.	2. Personalise.	3. Visualise.		
<u>Memorise:</u>	Commit verses to your memory.				
<u>Personalise:</u>	Quote them back to God in the first person, eg: "This book of the law shall not depart out of my mouth " I shall meditateetc.				
<u>Visualise:</u>	Picture each word. Ponder over it. See yourself doing what God's Word tells you to do. See yourself as God Himself sees you and says you are.

Attitudes: One of the chief areas where our thoughts and God's thoughts are at real variance is that which concerns ourselves. These conflicting thoughts and attitudes affect every other relationship in our life. This is why it is important to let our thoughts be renewed by the Word of god. As we start to see ourselves as God sees us, we overcome thoughts of self-rejection by others. It is so important to accept ourselves as we are (warts and all) and spend time developing a deeper personal relationship with God.
